THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL DIVISIONS

1. Exhibitor may enter any class. However, only two (2) items per class.
2. Exhibitor's name shall be on bottom of jar only. Contents label will be on lid only.
3. Entered items must have followed USDA Guidelines of approved methods.
4. Entered items must have been processed within the last three (3) years.
5. Jars may be opened to test flavor and consistency.
6. No gate admission tickets will be issued to exhibitor.
7. Exhibited items may be delivered between 9:00am and 2:00pm and ready for judging Friday, March 13th, 2009. Judging will begin at 3:00pm.
8. All containers must be clean and acceptable for canning with lids. Rusty, dirty or non-sealed jars will not be accepted.
9. Decision of the judges shall be final.
10. Exhibits must be removed from the grounds March 23rd or 24th by 12:00pm.
