6. Exhibited items may be delivered between 9:00am and 12:00pm, ready for judging at 3:00pm on Friday, March 13th, 2009.
7. Entries must be removed from the grounds March 23rd or 24th by 12:00pm.
8. All items must be clean and in good condition.
9. The decision of the judges shall be final.
